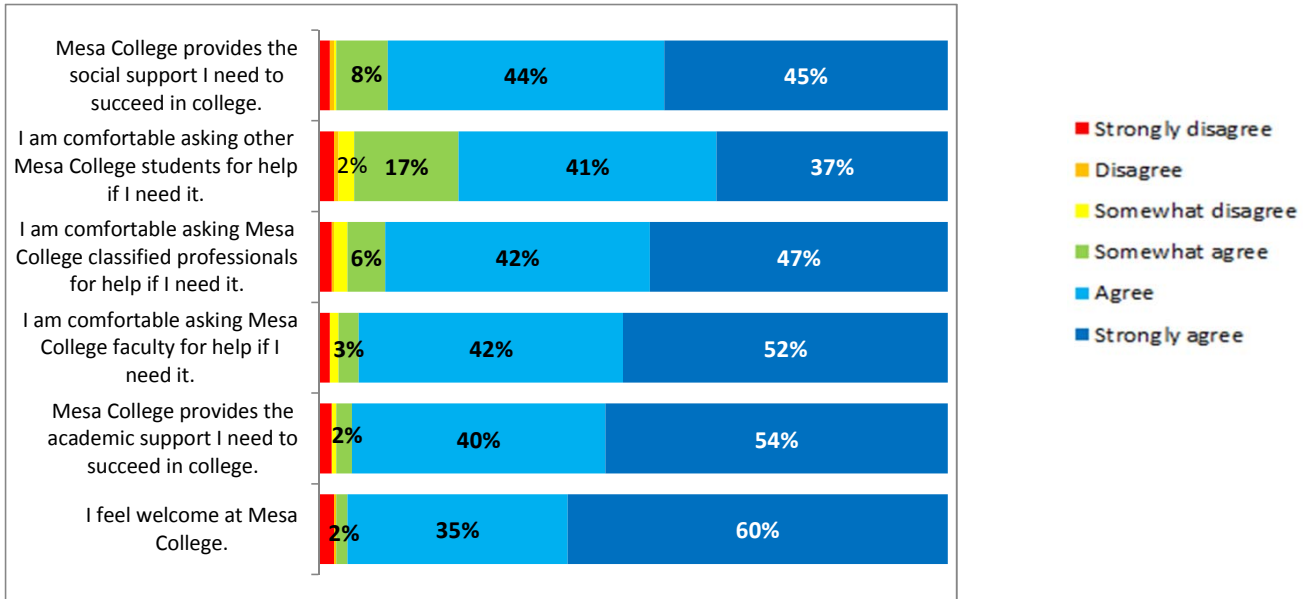
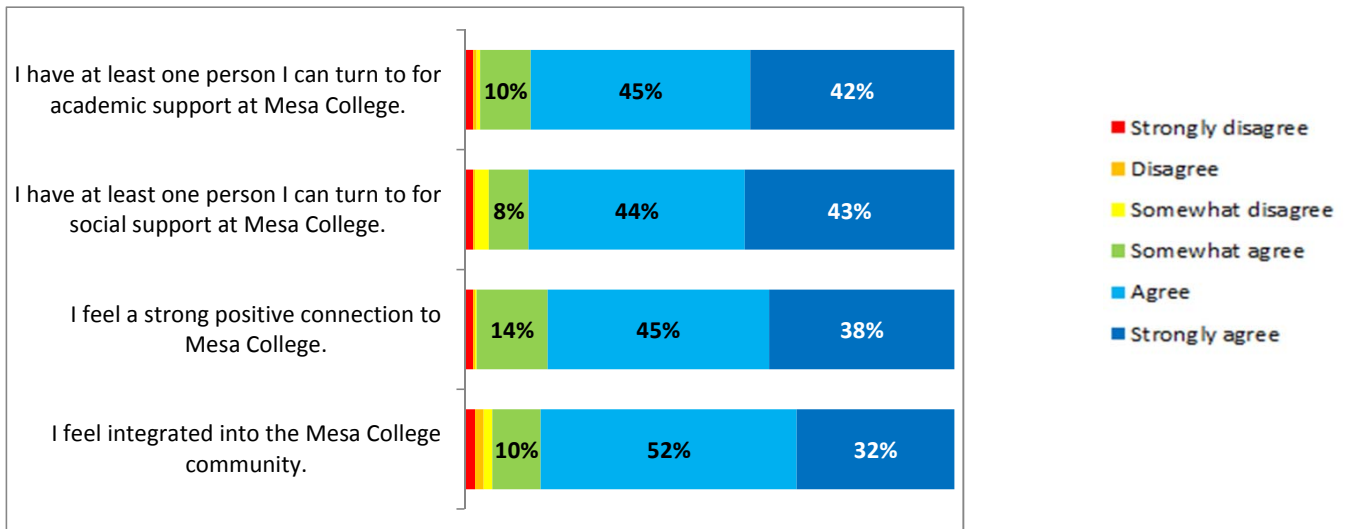

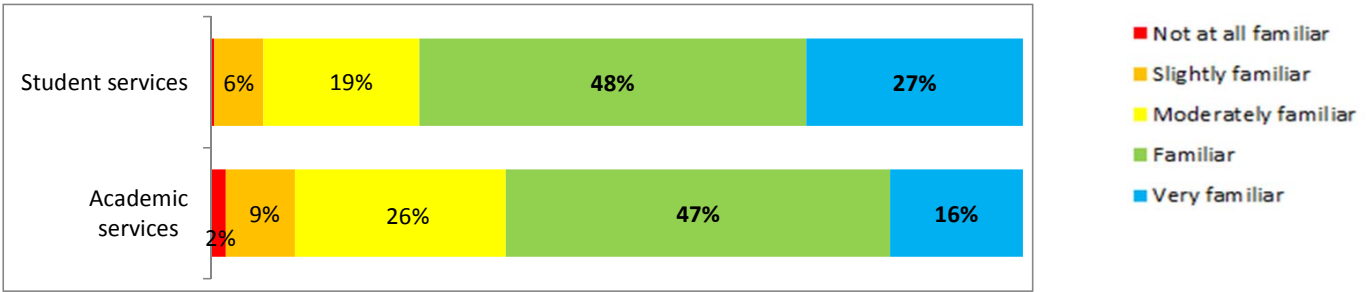
## 1. Reflecting on your experiences at Mesa College so far, please rate your agreement with the following statements using the scale below.



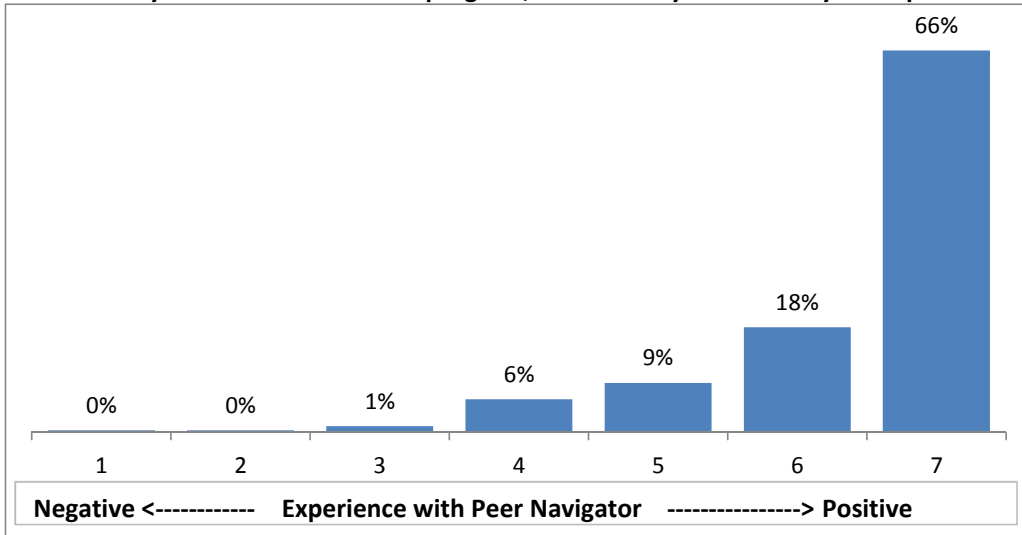

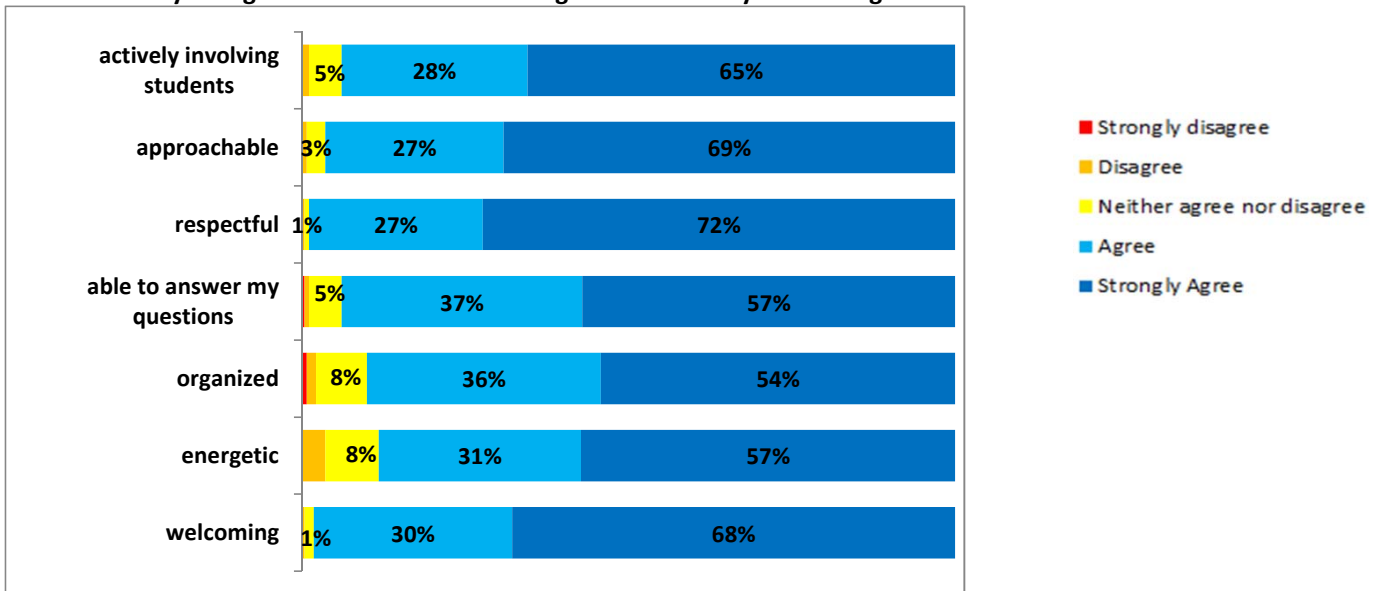
**3. How familiar are you with the following services and programs at Mesa College?**



**4. Based on your time in the CRUISE program, how would you describe your experience with your Peer Navigator?**



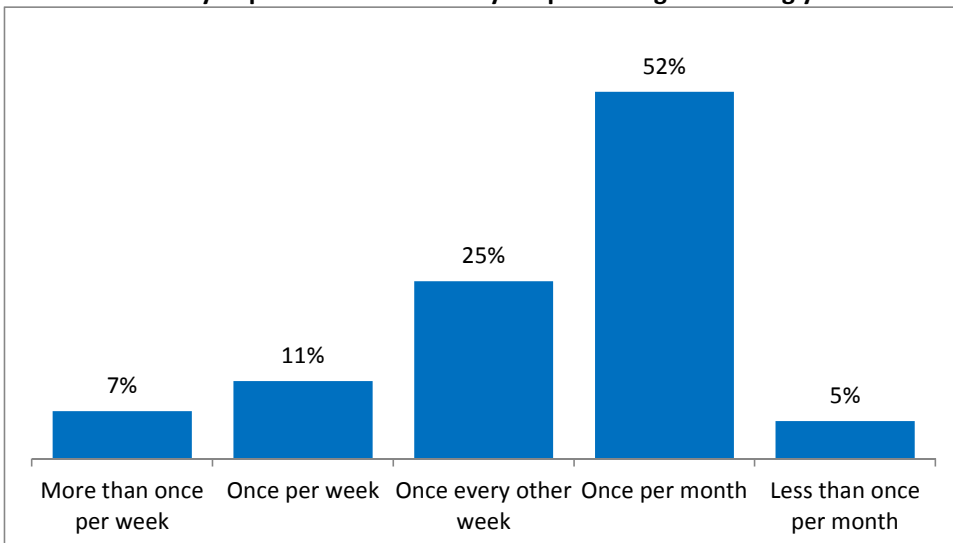

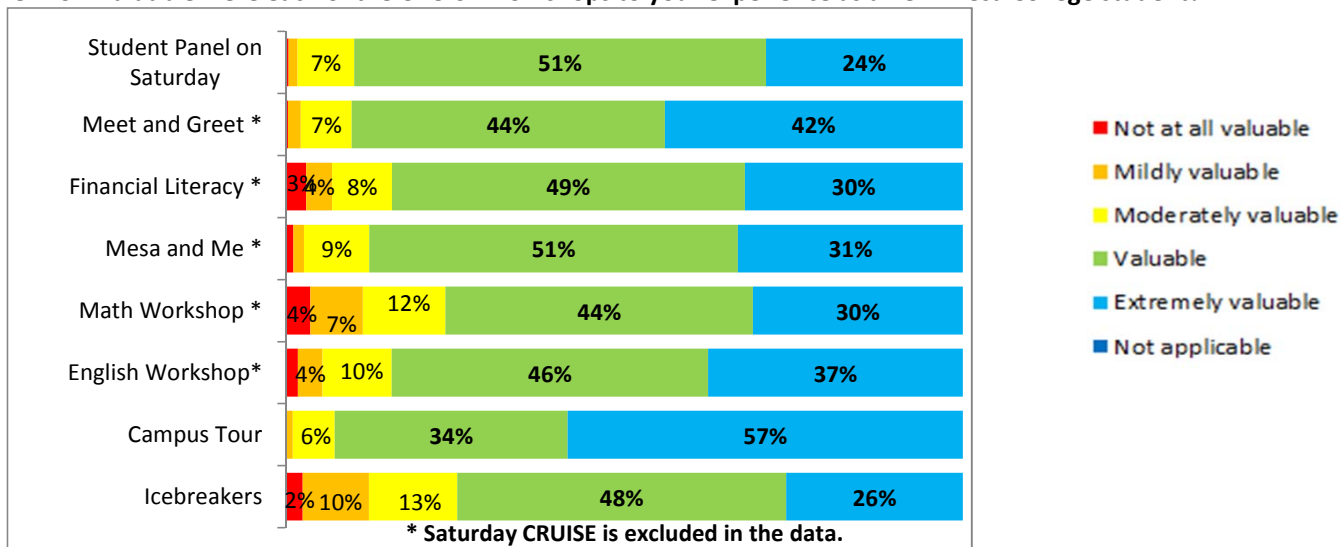

Dani, was a very good peer navigator. She's pretty funny and was very helpful to everyone answering all our questions.

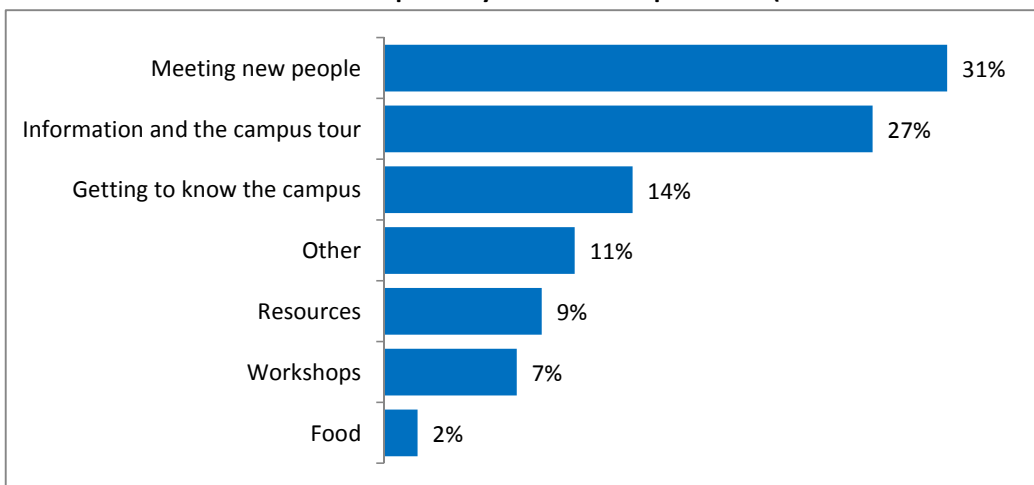
**7. How often do you plan to interact with your peer navigator during your first semester?**



**8. How valuable were each of the CRUISE workshops to your experience as a new Mesa College student?**



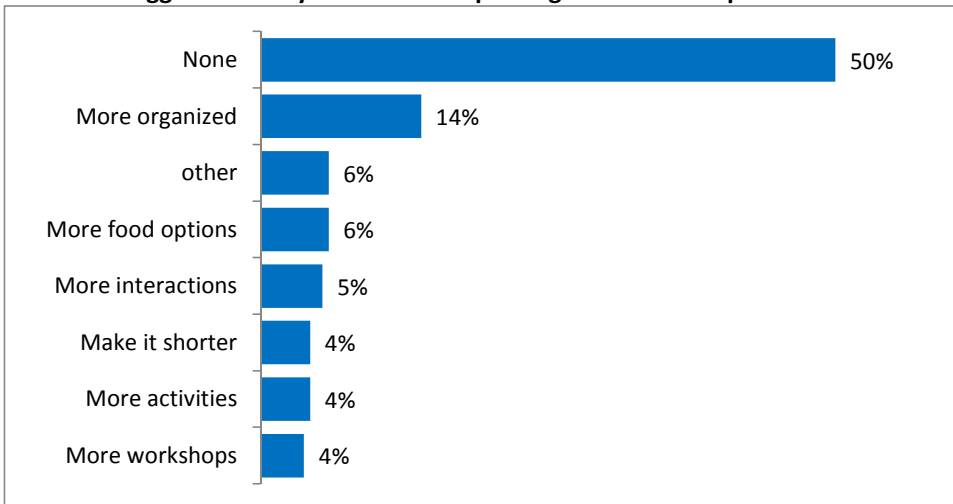

- Getting an idea of what type of career I can major in based on my personality and interests. It was enjoyable to

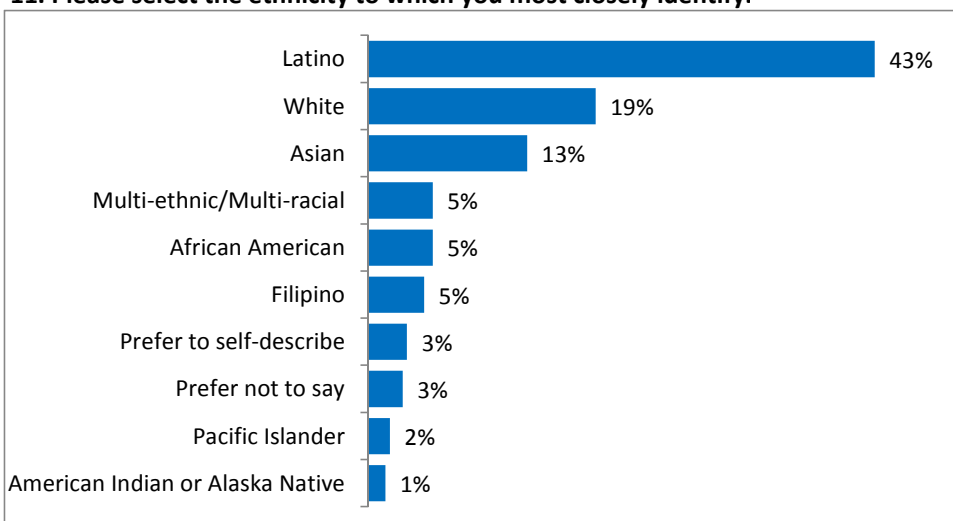

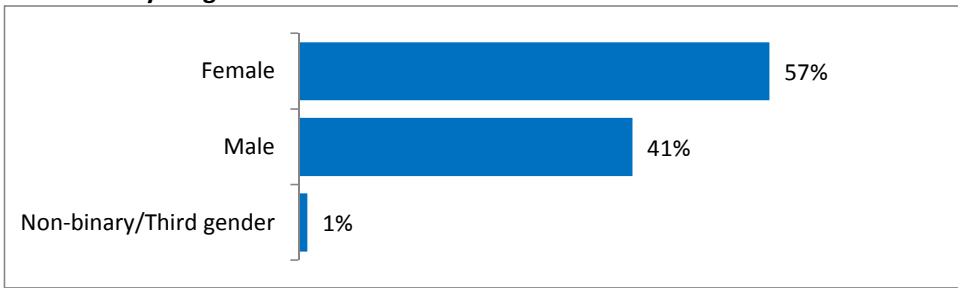
**Student Comments**

- Great program, maybe add snacks before lunch.

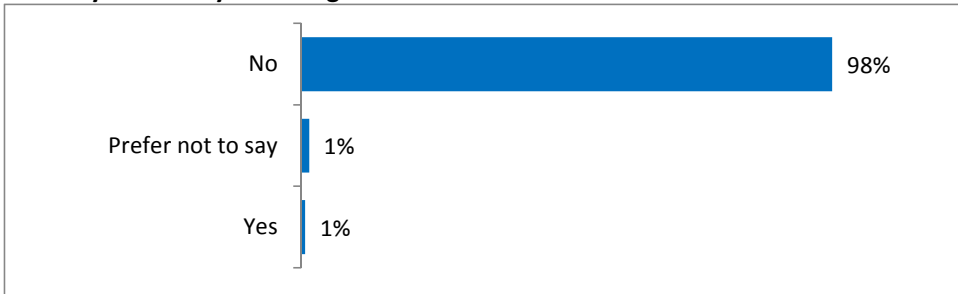
