ONGOING PROJECTS

- Assessment of Global Consciousness at the institutional level. Development of a ILO Taskforce that met in summer to develop a assessment. Assessment was revised and approved for distribution in fall. Assessment will be run in courses taught by faculty from the taskforce. Scoring will be completed in January and results posted by end of Spring semester.
- Campus climate survey for Outcomes Assessment has been completed and will be distributed later this semester
- Ongoing training for Outcomes Assessment
- Graduate survey revision currently in process
